Rules and Regulations

1. Contestants must be between the ages of 4 and 6 by September 1, 2011 and a resident of or attends a school in Waller County.
2. Contestant's parent(s) or guardian(s) and contestants agree the time, manner and method of judging shall be solely within the discretion of Rock Island 4-H Club and the decision of the judges **shall be final**.
3. Contestants and parent(s) and guardian(s) must attend a Mandatory meeting on Wednesday, August 31, 2011 at 6:00 pm at the Creative Living Building located at the Waller County Fairgrounds to be eligible to participate in the contest. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
Note: We will be taking pictures for the local newspapers at this meeting.
4. Contestants should wear western attire for the parade, interview and to the opening ceremony where the winners will be announced Shorts are not permissible. You may wear the same outfit to each appearance or you can change.
5. Release of Liability form must be signed and submitted with their entry form along with their entry fee & a 4x6 individual photograph of the contestant.
6. Winners will ride in the 2012 parades. It will be up to the parents(s) or guardian(s) to arrange this. Little Mr & Little Miss Waller County must appear on behalf of the Waller County Fair Association when asked. If for some reason the child is unable to fulfill his or her responsibility, (ex. moving out of the county) the first runner-up will assume the title.
7. The Waller County Fair Association, Rock Island 4-H Club and Waller County 4-H will not be responsible for loss, injury, or damage to person or property while a contestant is either on the fairgrounds or at any fair related function.
8. Entry forms, photo and an entry fee of \$30.00 must be turned in no later than Wednesday, August 31, 2011. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
9. In the interest of time, if there are more than 20 contestants, a preliminary contest will be held. Date and time TBA.
10. Ceremonies will be held opening day of the 2011 Waller County Fair on Saturday, September 24, 2011 at 7:00 pm. Contestants not present at this time will be automatically disqualified. All spectators will be required to pay a gate fee to enter the fairgrounds for the ceremonies.
